SAN DIEGO CITY TOUR & DINNER
Tuesday, July 1st, 1-7pm

By popular demand, we have added an exciting *San Diego City Tour* for those who will be arriving to the convocation early. It will be on **Tuesday, July 1st**. This private tour leaves the Hyatt at **1 PM** and will return at approximately **7 PM**. It includes a *fully narrated sightseeing trolley tour of San Diego*, several stops, and a *festive Mexican dinner* buffet at an internationally acclaimed Mexican restaurant in the ambience of a beautiful hacienda.

- After leaving the Hyatt, the tour starts with a drive through the *Gaslamp District* of downtown San Diego and continues to *Coronado Island*.
- The tour will drop everyone off at the famous *Hotel Del Coronado*. The Del has become a living legend with visits by celebrities, U.S. presidents, and dignitaries from around the world. Highlights include: the amazing architecture, Marilyn Monroe and other exhibits, shops, and the beach.
- The next stop is *Balboa Park*: Imagine wide green lawns, tinkling fountains, Spanish architecture, lush gardens... Balboa Park's 15 diverse museums span interests like aerospace, sports, fine art, folk art, history, and dinosaurs. It would take days to explore this National Park, but we'll drive through and stop to visit the famous Botanical Garden.
- Next, the sightseeing tour continues to *Old Town San Diego*, home of *Bazaar Del Mundo*. This special complex has the open, "olden-days" feel of San Diego circa 1821–1872, with five original adobes. You'll love the Bazaar del Mundo's tinkling fountain and fiesta atmosphere, where unusual shops with treasures from all over the world surround a flower-scented courtyard. There's a great toy store for kids and Mexican imports for adults.
- Our wonderful day culminates in a fun buffet dinner at a *spectacular Mexican restaurant* that is a landmark for Old Town San Diego. The ambience of *Casa Guadalajara* is reminiscent of a gracious hacienda deep in Mexico.
